From an anonymous outside source information was received on 8-4-40 that Morris Ernst was one of the sponsors of the New World Resettlement Fund, NYC (subject of 2-22).

The Chicago Field Office forwarded to the Bureau on 8-15-40 a Photostat of a memo entitled "NLRB Memo" obtained by a confidential informant of Miles Goldberg of the Anti-Defamation League from the desk of James True (subject of 61-7307), who was with the Industrial Control Commission, Washington, D.C.

The memo enclosed stated "Morris Ernst and his revolutionary statement which appeared in Mallon's column January 13, 1937. I have the original newspaper clipping in my file, considering it valuable. We have never done anything with this -- never quoted it even, as I recall it, but I have several times incorporated in mss., but never published. It is dynamite. Ernst is the A.C.L.U. lawyer and prepared the crackdown court case against Hague of Jersey City. He is tied in closely with the NLRB crowd, the LaFayette Committee, etc., to point of weariness."
