On 5-11-42 Morris L. Ernst at NYC advised that Nat Green, a NYC attorney, was being suggested for Counsel for Paul McNutt's Manpower Board. Ernst stated Green followed the CP line for years and opposed the entry of the U.S. in the war until Russia became involved.

Ernst also mentioned one Connelly, first name not recalled, was an official on the Rationing Board in NYC and was building up a semi-political following on the Rationing Board.

This reference is a memo for the Attorney General dated 5-25-42 advising him of an interview in NYC of T. O. Thackery, Editor of the "NY Post" (subject of 94-8-173), Marvin Berger, reporter for the paper, and Leo Rosen, attorney for the "Post", with regard to the Senator Walsh case. Rosen offered the suggestion that the Attorney General contact Morris Ernst whom Rosen thought, because of the Attorney General's friendship with Ernst, might furnish additional information which the "Post" might have concerning the case if he were given assurance of its use.
